Re: New Vendor Tier Levels

Dear Vendor,

The Santa Clara Pueblo Gaming Commission will be utilizing a new tier structure for all vendor licenses. Below are the guidelines for the new structure:

- •The new tiers will go into effect on April 1, 2011.
- •If your license renewal is due on or after April 1, 2011, you will be subject to the new tier structure.
- •Licenses will have a duration of twelve (12) months.
- •Tier levels are calculated based on the previous twelve (12) months gross revenue from the Santa Claran Hotel Casino or if a new vendor, based off of estimated gross revenues.
- •Gross revenues will be rounded up to the nearest whole dollar amount.
- •All vendors must also have a business vendor license from the Santa Clara Pueblo Tax Administrator's Office.

Below is a copy of the new tier rates.
